Position Description: Candidates are expected to contribute to the institutional strength of neuroscience research and submit applications for extramural funds in neuroscience research within their first year at the institution. Responsibilities included but are not limited to: 1) Development, preparation, and submission of the SNRP3 proposal. 2) Coordinate and promote the development of potential new research projects. 3) Supervise and train SNRP researchers in grantmanship, scientific presentations and research program development. 4) Manage the review of SNRP researchers' proposals before submission to funding agencies.

Effectiveness as a mentor of postdoctoral fellows and junior faculty.
